The Position

Methlick Parish Church seeks to appoint a new minister on a 0.5 FTE basis. This could be Sunday plus two other days. The working hours will form a key part of the discussion at interview.

This is a great opportunity for someone who is passionate about joining an active and growing church community, interested in gospel interpretation in relation to modern day challenges and how it can further guide our Church in attracting and supporting the wider community.

The overall purpose of the role is to give a solid foundation and fresh thinking to our regular worship services whilst providing leadership and guidance to everyone involved across all facets of church life.

The successful candidate will be required to draw up and deliver a coherent strategy to improve and grow our church community through prayer, congregational consultation and excellent community engagement.

The Role of Minister

The role will offer the successful candidate several opportunities and benefits including:

- Working in a friendly rural community in a much sought after part of Aberdeenshire with a diverse population.
- Living accommodation provided in a modern manse in the village of Methlick
- Ability to influence and drive new thinking with a supportive church family

- Interface with Presbytery, the wider Church of Scotland, other denominational groups and other local churches as agreed with our Session and Congregation

- Children and Youth are a major priority for our church and the need for a well thought out and ongoing plan to support and develop them is critical.
- Provide pastoral care at all levels
- Together with the Kirk session and Treasurer, ensure that the church operates efficiently and effectively from a financial perspective
